

Minutes of the meeting of the 3rd meeting of the IQAC for the session 2022-2023 was held on 12 February 2023

1. The minutes of the previous meeting were read out and confirmed.

2. In continuation of previously discussed issue related to organizing faculty development program Dr. Dilip Badwaik informed about finalization of one day online workshop on "Intellectual property Rights" in the month of March 2032 and one week National level Faculty Development Programme on "Research Methodolgy" and "ICT tools for effective teaching" in the month of June 2023, further to this Dr. Suresh Puppalwar pointed that there is an urgent need to organized regular faculty development programs for continuous improvement of teaching learning methods to meet the requirements as per new education policy. The principal said that the proposal will be considered and directed to present a blue print for the same. The idea was welcomed by all.

3. For the smooth functioning of admission process for the upcoming academic session admission committee was framed for both UG and PG courses.

4. Final review of the detailed action plan submitted by the departments was taken by the chairman. Based on the review the principal Dr. Dilip Badwaik directed to complete the remaining tasks as early as possible.

5. Advocate Abhijit Wanjarri raised awareness about the recently announced National Education Policy. He expressed that the policy aims to elevate teaching methods to a higher standard and guarantee quality education for all aspiring individuals. To facilitate a deeper understanding of the policy, he proposed arranging a seminar to explore its various components. Dr. Smeetaa Wanjarri additionally emphasized the importance of faculties encouraging the development of innovative pedagogies to enhance teaching and learning methods. All the members present unanimously agreed to take this initiative forward.

6. In a bid to enhance job opportunities and employability, in addition to traditional courses, the proposal for the introduction of new job-oriented courses was put forth. The chairman recommended pursuing courses like B.Com (Hons), B.Sc. (Data Science), B.A. (English Medium), and M.A. (Home Economics). He instructed that the proposal be prepared and submitted in adherence to the university's prescribed guidelines within the stipulated timeframe. All the members present unanimously expressed their consent and pledged to collaborate in accordance with this directive.

7. "Kalavishkar" is an enriching cultural program that empowers students to showcase their artistic and creative prowess, spanning literature, visual arts, and performing arts. This initiative not only promotes self-expression but also refines their artistic skills. Furthermore, the event nurtures a strong sense of community and camaraderie among students as they share their creative endeavors, forging connections that extend beyond the classroom. It serves as a platform for students to gain well-deserved recognition for their artistic talents, bolstering their confidence and self-esteem. All the members present unanimously expressed their consent.

8. Dr. S.D. Deshbhratar proposed an educational excursion where our students will have the unique opportunity to visit the Sansad Bhavan in New Delhi, a symbol of India's vibrant democracy. He further stated that this visit will provide them with an immersive experience, offering insights into the hallowed halls and valued spaces of the Republic of India, fostering a deeper understanding of our nation's governance and history. All the members agreed and appreciated the proposal and believed that this excursion will be a memorable and enlightening experience for our students.
