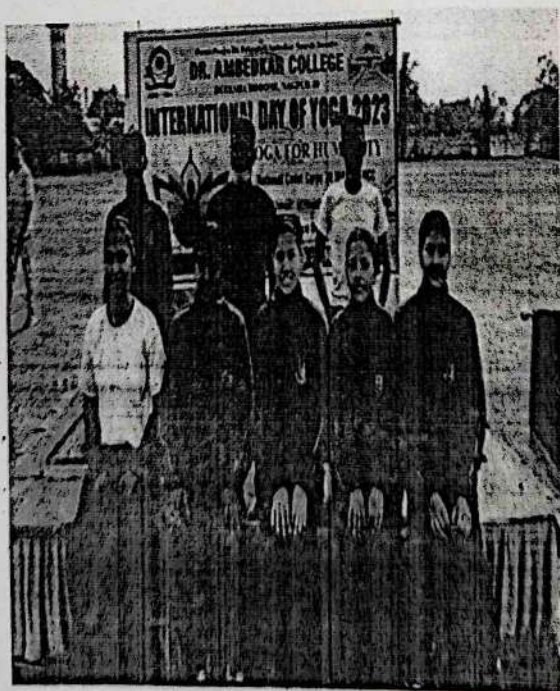

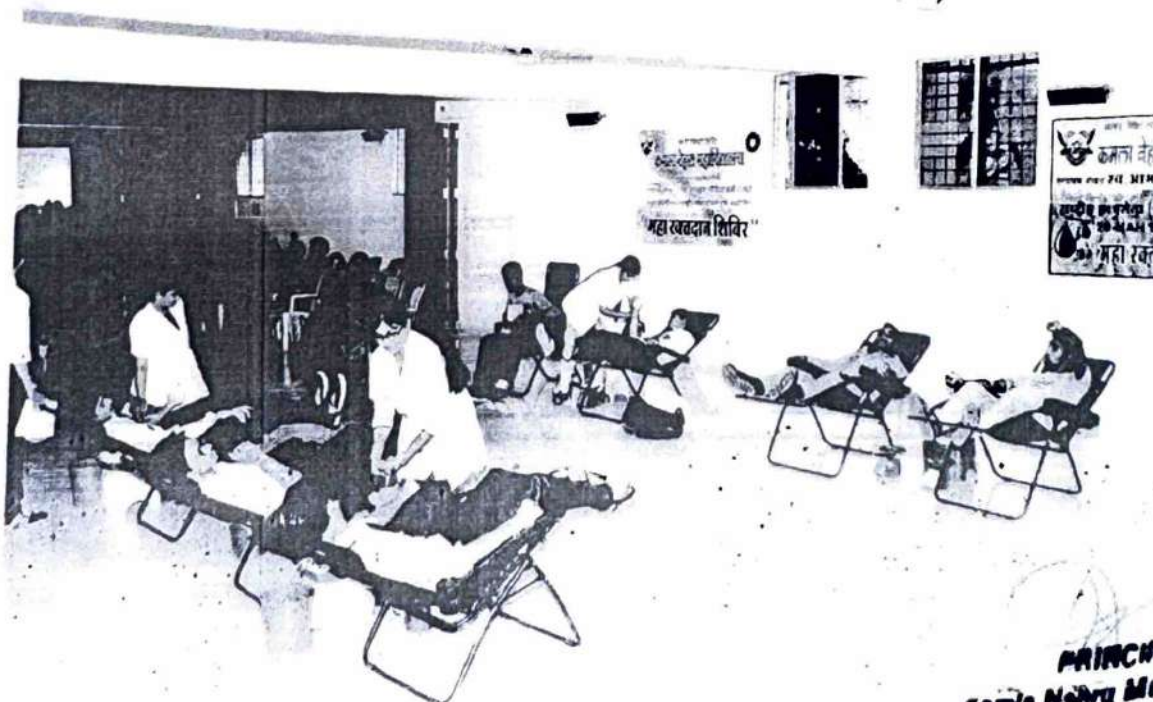

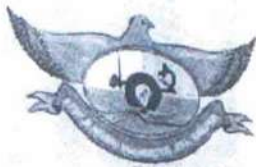
To motivate student and cadets to donate blood for social cause, remove the unawareness of people about the blood donation and raising awareness and importance of blood donation in the society.

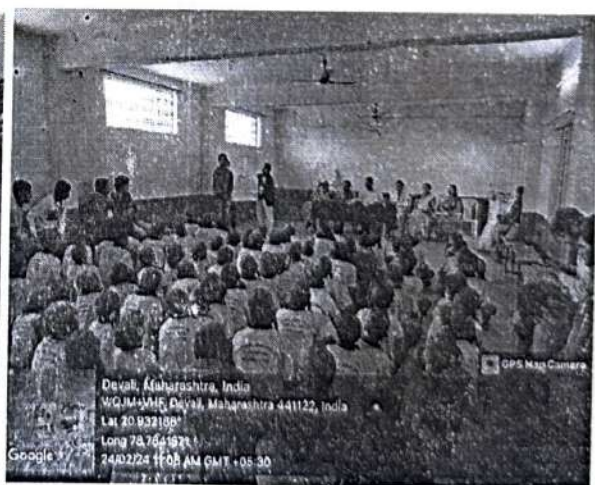
Actual Program:

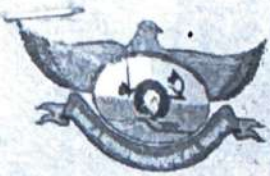

- To aware the sufferers of the supportive scheme and the services available for cancer patients.

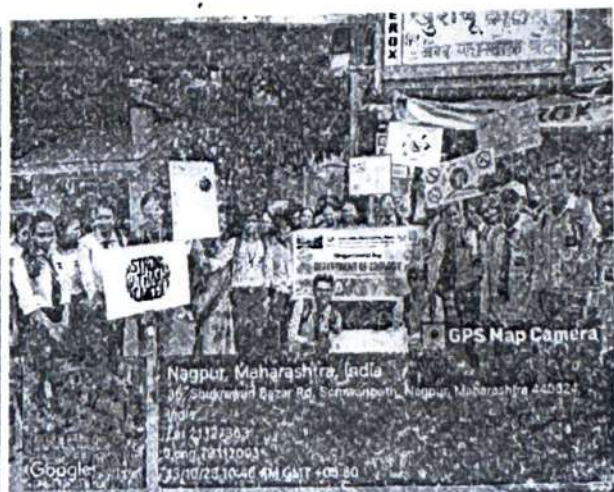
Actual program:
