AND

Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya, and represented herein by its Dr. Dilip S. Badwaik (Principal, Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya) (Competent Authority), (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

Preamble:

Founded in 1927, Maharashtra Chamber of Commerce, Industry & Agriculture is Apex Chamber of the State. Currently over 5 lakh business establishments of state are affiliated with Maharashtra Chamber of Commerce, making it the apex body of state which does advocacy for trade and industrial development of the state & country. Maharashtra Chamber of Commerce (MACCIA) has affiliations of Maharashtra's most regional industry bodies and individual business establishments representing credible industry views.

Business Solutions Polyclinic Program (BSPP) is concept developed by MACCIA. JugaadFunda Innovations LLP empower the program as execution partner through their CREAT-JOB Innovation Ecosystem platform. This program is aimed at connecting different stakeholders of the innovation ecosystem. It enables every stakeholder to contribute and fetch benefits equally. BSPP program is looking forward to empowering 5 Lakhs plus industries and more than 3000+ academic institutions and 1000+ Mentors from Maharashtra in next 3 years.

Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL BENEFITS THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: AREA OF COLLABORATION AND SCOPE OF MOU

- 1.1 The aim of this MOU is primarily to establish non-commercial terms of collaboration and co-operation, under which both the parties seeking the MOU- may perform collaborative interests & organizational goals.
- 1.2 Broadly, the areas of collaboration in this MOU are focusing on improvement in

following areas for benefit of both industry as well as academia.

- A) Holistic Interdisciplinary Environment Creation
- B) Training & Skill Development (staff, students, industry)
- C) Focus on Academic activities (performance skill based)
- D) Recruitment related activities (employable product)

- 1.3 Organizing Industry institute joint summit, "On-Line + Off-Line (Hybrid Mode)", enabling both stake holders to express their views / expectations / challenges and discuss possible solutions to overcome them.
- 1.4 Engage Industry leaders in 2 days "On-Line + Off-Line (Hybrid Mode)" faculty development program per semester to bridge the gap between industry and academia.
- 1.5 Engage best performing students in 1 day "On-Line + Off-Line (Hybrid Mode)" Industry Orientation program.
- 1.6 Organize project competition "On-Line + Off-Line (Hybrid Mode)", enabling best projects from institutes to get presented in front of industries.
- 1.7 Any other activity outside the scope mentioned above can be discussed separately and can be included by agreeing its terms of association in writing. If required separate MOU also can be signed if additional activity demands.

CLAUSE 2: CO-OPERATION AND KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1 Both Parties are willing to unite by common interests and objectives mentioned under clause 1 and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the territory/ campus / affiliated institutes & departments of Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional value addition opportunities for one another.
- 2.2 Both parties shall nominate 3-member team from each side as point of contact team for effective communication, promotion, and operation supervision.
- 2.3 Understanding the fact that execution is an important task for success of the purpose of this MOU, "MACCIA execution partner" shall be responsible for execution of the tasks under this MOU. Three-member team from parties shall extend their support to

provide required information to enable execution partner for communication, promotion, operation, and execution of the program. Sole responsibility of execution and derive measurable outcome from the activity is with the "execution partner".

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel (the principle which precludes a person from asserting something contrary to what is implied by a previous action or statement of that person or by a previous pertinent judicial determination) or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: IMPLEMENTATION METHODOLOGY

- 4.1 All process for registration under this MOU will be guided through information and registration link developed by execution partner on www.maccia.org.in/bspp.php and www.jugaadfundra.com

CLAUSE 5: LOGO USAGE

- 5.1 At all functions/literature related to this MOU activities, both party and execution partner logos will be displayed with equal prominence. Logos usage will be permitted for such designs for promotion of BSPP Program and other mutually agreed programs in writing.

CLAUSE 6: VALIDITY

- 6.1. This MOU is valid, until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms. Review report shall get prepared after every year to evaluate the performance and progress under the MOU. Based on these reports, a detailed outcome focused review will be taken about continuance and further terms of operation based on experience. As a part of this MOU, second party can subscribe separately to get benefitted with other services. All such services and their scope of operation shall get defined separately. Both parties shall fulfill their deliverables under committed program/activity if any at the time of termination.

CLAUSE 7: RELATIONSHIP AND GOVERNING LAWS

- 7.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
- 7.2 Governing laws and arbitration: The MOU shall be construed and governed by the laws of India. Any controversy or claim arising out of or divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU or breach thereof shall be resolved/settled by arbitration, to be held in Mumbai as in accordance with the rules of the arbitration and conciliation Act 1996.



- i. In the Publications arising out of this program authorship must be given to Institute Scientist/Lecturer and Students (either as first or second author).
- j. The Intellectual Property of the work carried out at Sai Biosystems will be reset with the Institute.

2.0. Effective Date, Duration, Termination of the Agreement

2.1.1. The agreement shall be effective from the (date of signing/specify events) and shall be recurring in force for **five years** from said date.

2.1.2. During the tenure of the agreement, parties hereto can terminate the agreement either for breach of any of the terms and conditions of this agreement or otherwise by giving a (three month) notice in writing to the defaulting party failure of either party to terminate the agreement on account of breach or default or other shall not constitute a waiver of that party's right to terminate this agreement.





TERMS AND CONDITION:



Tijare, Director, Tijare Engineering & Research Corporation (hereinafter referred as '**First Party**', company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya, Second party represented herein by its Dr. Dilip S. Badwaik (Principal, Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya) (Competent Authority), (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as '**Parties**' and individually as '**Party**')

Preamble:

Tijare Engineering & Research Corporation (First Party): Founded in 2018, Tijare Engineering & Research Corporation, situated at Amravati, Maharashtra is registered under Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) with UAM No. MH03D0006392. Company works for developing new technologies and insist to generate maximum employment for India. Company is also working for utilization of CSR funds under authorized organization.

Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya (Second Party): Founded in 1983, Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya run by Amar Sewa Mandal, situated at Nagpur city, Maharashtra is Affiliated to RTM, Nagpur University and Recognized by Govt. of Maharashtra. The

- 1.2 Broadly, the areas of collaboration in this MOU are focusing on improvement in following areas for benefit of both industry as well as academia.

CLAUSE 2: CO-OPERATION AND KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1 Both Parties are willing to unite by common interests and objectives mentioned under clause 1 and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation

that will promote and advance their respective operations within the territory/ campus / affiliated institutes & departments of Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya and its related wings. CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 4.1. This MOU is valid, until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms. Review report shall get prepared after every year to evaluate the performance and progress under the MOU. Based on these reports, a detailed outcome focused review will be taken about continuance and further terms of operation based on experience. Both parties shall fulfill their deliverables under committed program/activity if any at the time of termination.

CLAUSE 5 : RELATIONSHIP AND GOVERNING LAWS

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

7.2 Governing laws and arbitration: The MOU shall be construed and governed by the laws of India. Any controversy or claim arising out of or divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU or breach thereof shall be resolved /settled by arbitration, to be held in Mumbai as in accordance with the rules of the arbitration and conciliation Act 1996.

**AGREEMENT FOR COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION,
TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL OF BIO MEDICAL WASTE.**

THIS AGREEMENT is executed on this 22nd day of December 2022 at Nagpur.

BETWEEN

M/s. SUPERB HYGIENIC DISPOSALS, NAGPUR.

(POWER OF ATTORNEY HOLDER) on the behalf of its Managing

Partner, **Mr. ATUL S/O MAROTRAO ZOTING**

Aged about 43 yrs., Occupation – Business

R/O Nagpur. Hereinafter called as service provider **(PARTY NO.1)**

AND

Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya (hereinafter referred to as 'KNM'); a college run by Amar Sewa Mandal's having registration no. M/220/78 NGP, F-2299(N) having its college at Sakkardara Square Nagpur - 440024 and is engaged in imparting quality education to student in arts, commerce and science management streams.

Hereinafter called waste generator **(PARTY NO.2).**



That the service provider / party No. 1 is having a Bio Medical Waste disposal unit. And the service provider / Party No. 1 is engaged in the business of Collection, Transportation, Treatment & Disposal of Bio Medical Waste.

That the waste generator / Party No. 2 is having life Science departments
Kamala Nehru Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur.

In the laboratory of 1 Life Science Department, Waste generator is having **Used Media, Cotton plugs, glasswares used during Microbiological Practical etc.** generated a Bio-Medical Waste.

On the request of Party No. 2, Party No.1 has agreed to undertake the work of collection, transportation and disposal Bio Medical Waste generated in the Hospital/ Clinic/Laboratories of party No. 2 on the following terms and condition.

- 1) Waste generator hereby declares that in his Hospital, he is having **Life Science departments including Microbiology, Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Environmental Science.**
- 2) Service provider / Party No. 1 has accepted the work of collection, transportation and disposal of entire Bio Medical Waste of the waste generator.
- 3) The waste generator will arrange itself non-chlorinated coloured plastic bags approved by pollution control board for stocking and packing of Bio-medical waste.
- 4) The Waste generator will arrange collection and proper segregation of entire Bio-medical waste generated in its various departments and wards as per the guidelines of the Bio-medical waste management and disposal rules 2016, and its segregation as per details annexed. Party No.1 has agreed to collect the Bio-Medical waste at source during 9 am to 6 pm or any other time, which may be mutually agreed upon.
- 5) The waste generator will pack the segregated Bio-medical waste as per rules at the **collection end point** in Colour coded bags label the said bags as per schedule IV (rule 6) of the Bio-medical waste (management and handling) rules 1998 and amended 2003 and amended 2016 as per section 6, 8 and 25 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986. It is the responsibility of the Party No. 1 to collect, Transport and dispose of the Bio-medical waste.
- 6) The waste generator undertakes to deliver to the service provider only the segregated Bio-medical waste generated on Alternate Day basis, general waste i.e. **(municipal solid waste) is not to be put into the service provider's bags at all** for any violation of the Bio-medical rules in this regard the waste generator shall be exclusively responsible.
- 7) That the waste generator agreed that they would pay service provider charges, as per the charges approved by Nagpur Municipal Corporation for Collection, Transportation, Processing and disposal of Bio-Medical Waste and Covid Bio-Medical Waste .



- 8) No change or modification or waiver of any of the terms of this agreement shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by duly authorized officer of each of the parties hereto.
- 9) Party No. 1 the service provider and Waste generator agreed that this agreement is valid from 22/12/2022 to 21/12/2023. And after the expiry of the said period of this agreement, the parties will renew the agreement on fresh terms and conditions as would be mutually agreed upon.
- 10) All disputes and questions in connection with this deed arising between parties shall be referred to the arbitration of the two arbitrator one to be appointed by each party and in case of their disagreement to an umpire appointed by the said arbitrator or in case of their default by the parties.
- 11) In the event there is any objection and / or notice for breach of the rules regarding transportation treatment and disposal of bio-medical waste, Party No. 1 shall be solely responsible in that behalf.
- 12) In the event the party No. 1 commits any default in the service the Party No. 2 shall be at liberty to discontinue this agreement with prior written notice of one month.
- 13) This agreement is executed in Duplicate; one original signed copy will remain with party No. 2.


This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is made on this Feb. 18 day of the month of February in the year 2022 by and between the **ICAR- Central Institute of Cotton Research, Nagpur** having its Head Office at Nagpur [hereinafter called [First party], a constituent Research Institution of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi-110 001 on the ONE PART and the **Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur** State Government Funded Private Institute having its headquarter at Nagpur [Second party] on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties).


The parties, having discussed fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into long-term collaboration for promotion of students' training and quality postgraduate research in cutting edge areas in accordance with the provisions contained in the Guidelines issued vide Letter No. 2-8/2012-HRD dated 11th December, 2012 or as revised from time to time.

WHEREAS the "First Party" is involved in the studies on Cotton research such as Biotechnology, Molecular Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Entomology, Microbiology, Botany (Genetics and Plant breeding, seed technology, plant physiology), Plant Pathology, Agri Extension, Economics and Agriculture engineering.

AND WHEREAS the "Second Party", established vide F. No1277/122166/82 dated June 1983 by Govt. of India/Govt. of Maharashtra State (Amar Seva Mandal's Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya) vide Act No. 1956 of section 2F and 12 B and recognized by University Grants Commission] at its Department of Science, Arts and Commerce is involved in the Education of degree M. Sc. In Biotechnology, Chemistry, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Botany, Zoology, Environmental Science, Electronics and Physics

AND WHEREAS it has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the projects requiring expertise and logistics from both the parties.

Article 1. Scope

- 1.1 The Second party will recognize the First party as an Institute for conducting research related to the thesis requirement of the research students for
(Name of the degree programme). The Second party will recognize Scientists of the ICAR Institute as recommended by its Director in accordance with the University rules and regulations for guiding students working for the said degree.
- 1.2 Operational details of research effort and collaboration will be made in common research programmes and/or projects restricted to specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines/divisions. The objective(s) for research work for a student coming from a Second party outside NARS should be exclusively different as far as possible.
- 1.3 Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the First party and the Second party will be made available to the faculty and research scholars. However, the costs of specific consumables will be borne by the respective organizations.
- 1.4 There shall be an exchange of students for academic, research and training purposes. Accommodation in the Hostel shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates. The duration of exchange visits will be determined by mutual consent between both the parties.

Article 2. Management


- 2.1 Director of the First party and the Vice-Chancellor/Head of the Institution of the Second party will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 2.2 The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively in the institutions of the First party and the Second party to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and research activities, which should be open to the students, faculty and scientists.

Article 3. Exchange of Information

- 3.1. The term "information" includes scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation, and other information intended to be provided, exchanged, or arising under project descriptions entered into pursuant to this MoU.
- 3.2. The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information. Each party in joint projects shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information for any and all purposes.

Article 4. General Provisions

- 4.1 It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.

- 4.2 Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.
- 4.3 Both parties acknowledge that exchange of students from one party to the other shall be subject to the availability of funds and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the First party and the Second party.
- 4.4 Any research publications arising will be jointly published in accordance with the provisions laid out in Item 3.2.1C of the Guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree programme as trainees at ICAR institutions as notified *vide* Letter No. 2-8/2012-HRD dated 11th December, 2012 or revised guidelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time.
- 4.5 A copy of the thesis/dissertation will be submitted to the First Party after the award of the degree by the Second party.
- 4.6 All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution failing which an arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement of dispute, if any.
- 4.7 All questions not foreseen related to this MoU will be handled by the parties by mutual agreement.
- 4.8 Nothing in this MoU is intended to affect other cooperation or collaborations between the parties.

Article 5. Intellectual Property Rights

- 5.1 The Second party will be expected to ensure protection of the Intellectual Property Rights generated or likely to be generated during the student's research work. The ICAR as the first applicant (for its institute) and the Second party shall be the joint applicants for IPRs and the students and involved scientific staff shall be included as the inventor/breeder/author. The 'ICAR Guidelines for Intellectual Property Management and Technology Transfer/Commercialization' as amended from time to time shall be the reference for exploitation of the generated intellectual property, whose management and benefits sharing shall be mutually decided in each case.

Article 6. Admission and Fees

- 6.1 All those who wish to register as trainees or for Master/Doctoral programme under this MoU must apply for admission at the Second party. The allocation of Major Guide/Advisor would be finalized before the registration and will be governed by the provisions laid out in Items 3.2.1A and 3.2.2A of the Guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree programmes as trainees at ICAR institutions as notified *vide* Letter No. 2-8/2012-HRD dated 11th December, 2012 or revised Guidelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time, for the students from within NARS and outside NARS, respectively.
- 6.2 Admission of the students and the award of degrees for different programmes will be the responsibility of the Second party as per the rules and regulations.
- 6.3 Allotment of the students at the First party will be done by the approval of Director of the First party and Vice-Chancellor/Head of the Institution of the Second party.
- 6.4 The First party would have the right to screen the student's eligibility for admission based on their academic period.



- 6.5 The PME Cell of the First party in consultation with the representative of the Second party shall decide the location and sharing quantum of research work.
- 6.6 The number of student(s) at any particular time will be subjected to the availability of research facilities and scientists' time to guide thesis research at the First party institution.
- 6.7 Any student(s) admitted to the First party for training/postgraduate research, if found violating the rules and regulations laid down by the First party or indulge in such activities that amount to tarnishing the image of the Institute, or cause damage to the property, the registration of such student(s) would be summarily terminated. The Second party will not complete the formalities of issuing the certificates to such students until they compensate the losses to the First party.
- 6.8 Fees will be charged from the students by the First party as per Guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree programmes as trainees at ICAR

Institutions vide Letter No. 2-8/2012-HRD dated 11th December, 2012 or revised Guidelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time. No fee may be charged by the First party from the students registered with AU/DU within NARS. However a student registered with a Second party, outside NARS, will deposit fee of Rs. 10,000/- for training duration of 3 months (not leading to a degree/dissertation) and Rs. 30,000/- per semester (six months) for training, research, dissertation exceeding three months. Any change in fee structure by ICAR will be applicable from the date of revision and shall be charged by the First party.

Article 7. Entry into effect, modification and termination

- 7.1. This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for three years extendable up to five years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the end of each three/five year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.
- 7.2. All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.
- 7.3 No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.







CL.1. THE MOU

CL.1. This MOU made and entered into on this 11st day of March 2022, between Department of Botany, Kamla Nehru Mahavidyalaya (hereinafter referred to as DBKNM and the expression shall include all its present and future units) at Sakkardara square, Umred road, Nagpur of the one part and Arranya Paryavaran B.S. Sanstha Nagpur (hereinafter referred to as AEO) Nandanvan Nagpur.440009

CL.2 PREAMBLE

CL.2.1 WHEREAS the AEO is desirous of collaborating with DBKNM of the one part of research work related with Plantation, nature conservation activities, and related workshops, nursery management, tree walks, seed collection drives, other any Activities

CL.3 SCOPE OF THE MOU

CL.3.1 The agreement details the terms and conditions, financial arrangements, Modalities of collaboration, intellectual property rights, responsibilities and obligations of the AEO and DBKNM, pertaining to the collaborative research and certain short-term courses Along with activities .

CL.4 FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

CL.4.1 Both the parties shall share the inputs on mutually agreed basis for the research work in the areas of mutual interest.

CL.5. MODALITIES OF COLLABORATION

CL 5.1 There will be joint Monitoring Group for the project. The Monitoring Group shall consist of three or four number of persons each from DBKNM and the AEO. The Monitoring Group will identify the work to be done by the said college and the AEO, the targets/milestones and criteria for completion of the project.

CL.6 RESULT OF THE PROJECT

CL.6.1 The parties shall consult each other for any publication in respect of the projects. These publications (Papers, reports, etc.) shall be in the names of research workers, where in it will be duly acknowledged that the work has been carried out under the collaborative programme between the parties, the AEO will have no claim over the patents, publication related to the projects completed by the college not in collaboration and vice-versa.

CL.7. FORCE MAJEURE

CL.7.1 Neither AEO shall be responsible for the non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to strike, lockouts, epidemics, riots, civil war, commotion and natural calamities like flood, earthquakes provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the AEO affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other AEO within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force-majeure conditions continue beyond six month , the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

CL.8. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION, TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT.

CL.8.1 The agreement shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of 60 month from the said date.

CL.8.2 The agreement shall terminate on the expiry of the period, as in clause 8.1 unless extended by both the parties.

CL.8.3 During the tenure of the agreement, parties hereto can terminate the agreement either for breach of any of the terms and condition of this agreement or otherwise by giving a one-month notice in writing to the defaulting AEO. Failure of either AEO to terminate the agreement on account

of breach or default by the other shall not constitute waiver of the AEO's right to terminate this agreement.

CL.9 AMENDMENT OF THE AGREEMENT

CL.9.1 No amendment or modification of this agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or this authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this agreement. The modification/ changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

CL.10. ASSIGNMENT OF THE AGREEMENT

CL.10.1 The right of the liabilities arising to any AEO to this agreement shall not be assigned except with written consent of other AEO and subject to such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.


CL .11 ARBITRATION


CL .11.1 Except as herein before provided, any dispute arising out of this agreement, the same shall be referred to the arbitration of arbitrators, one to be appointed by each AEO to the dispute, and in case of difference of opinion between them to an committee appointed by the said two arbitrators before entering on the reference, and decision of such arbitrators or umpire and the arbitration proceeding shall take place under the Indian Arbitration Act, 1996.
